Reasons We are Restricting Individuals from Entering our Building

The current COVID-19 outbreak situation means that it is critical that we take every precaution possible. We must do what we can to prevent this virus from entering Hillcrest. Protecting our residents'/your loved ones' health and safety is our top priority.

The CDC has done a careful review of the death rate in the elderly, especially those with chronic diseases. Experts are recommending we take action to limit individuals from entering our building and to ensure sick employees stay home.

Early data shows that

- The mortality rate for people over the age of 80 in the general population is 15% in China.
- The World Health Organization report estimates the mortality rate at 21.9% for those over 80.
- At the nursing home in Washington state, there have been 50 residents who have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. As of March 9, 2020, 19 of those have died. This is a high death rate.

There is a risk that people who appear healthy will visit nursing homes and infect residents. Studies show that the sooner we limit interactions with each other and wash our hands frequently, virus spreads more slowly.

These facts have led many to recommend severe limitations on visitors. This notice describes why we have taken this action now. This situation is evolving and further restrictions may be implemented.

We hope this explains to you why we are asking people to limit their visits. This may prevent you from physically seeing your family member or friend. Our residents' health and safety are our top concern. We are committed to doing everything we can to protect them.
